- 3** To help connect deacons in their presbyteries and to the wider Church.


WORKSHOPS

We are planning a series of practical, interactive workshops addressing areas where local deacons have expressed needs and where they are also likely to have created some "best practices." Each workshop will be 90 minutes in length; all conference participants will have the opportunity to participate in each workshop in a similar setting of approximately 25 people. The goal is to focus on specific issues, explore biblical guidance relevant to that issue, and then work in break-out sessions to discuss cases, share experiences, and identify ideas to put into action.

DR. PHILIP GRAHAM RYKEN



Dr. Philip Graham Ryken is the eighth president of Wheaton College, where he studied philosophy and English literature and met his wife Lisa during orientation. He earned a Master of Divinity degree from Westminster Theological Seminary

and a doctorate in historical theology from the University of Oxford. Dr. Ryken returned from England to join the pastoral staff at Philadelphia's Tenth Presbyterian Church, where he preached for 15 years. He has published more than 30 books, including *The Message of Salvation*; Ryken's Bible Handbook; *Art for God's Sake*; and expository commentaries on Exodus, Ecclesiastes, Luke, and other books of the Bible. The Rykens have five children: Josh, Kirsten, Jack, Kathryn, and Caroline.

MR. STEVE CORBETT



Mr. Steve Corbett is an Assistant Professor of Community Development at Covenant College and serves as a Distance Learning Trainer for the Chalmers Center. Previously, Mr. Corbett served as Director of Field Operations and Training for the Chalmers Center. Prior to coming to Covenant College, Steve worked for Food for the Hungry International (FHI) as the Regional Director for Central and South America for two years. Before assuming these responsibilities, he served as the Director of Staff Training for nine years. In this capacity, he participated in the orientation and training of 1,500 staff working in 25 countries. Mr. Corbett has a B.A. from Covenant College and a M. Ed. in Adult Education from the University of Georgia.
